Mr. Mike McCurry (Moderator)

Mr. McCurry is a distinguished professor of Public Theology at Wesley Theological Seminary, McCurry has served as press secretary to multiple politicians, including President Bill Clinton. Previously he served as spokesperson for the Department of State and director of communications for the Democratic National Committee.

Ms. Michelle Boorstein (Panelists)

Ms. Boorstein became a religion reporter for the Washington Post in 2006. She is a member of the Religion Newswriters Association, where she was awarded "Religion Reporter of the Year" for large news organizations in both 2011 and 2013. She has spoken and moderated several panels surrounding religious freedom, liberty, and tolerance.

The Honorable Lincoln Davis (D-TN, 2003-2011) (Panelists)

Mr. Davis represented Tennessee in Congress for eight years. Davis served on the powerful Appropriations committee during his final term in Congress. Davis chaired the National Prayer Breakfast and was a leader in the weekly bi-partisan Prayer Group.

The Honorable Amo Houghton (R-NY, 1987-2005) (Panelists)

Mr. Houghton was a Member of Congress for nearly two decades. He founded the Republican Main Street Coalition, which sought to strengthen the political center among moderate Republicans. He was also Co-Chairman of the Faith and Politics Institute, a non-profit bipartisan interfaith organization which seeks to collaboration between lawmakers of different races, religions, and political parties.

The Honorable Frank Wolf (R-VA, 1981-2015) (Panelists)

Mr. Wolf was a Virginia Member of Congress until earlier this year. Wolf was known for his commitment to the protection of human rights and against religious persecutions. In January 2015, Wolf became a Distinguished Senior Fellow with the 21st Century Initiative and was appointed the first-ever Wilson Chair in Religious Freedom at Baylor University.
